
When I have raised concerns with the school they have been dealt with properly

# Feedback

We have to date had 39 responses, with a fairly equal balance between the two schools.

On the whole, the feedback is very positive. All but 2 parents would recommend the respective schools to other parents, which I am very happy to hear. I would however be keen to know how things can be improved so that we have 100% positive feedback.

Some responses are neutral and the overwhelming theme for me is that parents would like more feedback about how their child is doing, or more information about what their child is learning. In response to this, please remember that all long term plans are on our school websites. Staff have also put this term's topic on the class page on DB Primary and on the website and you have access to Seesaw so that you can see examples of children's learning.

The vast majority of children are happy and feel safe in both schools. From the responses given, bullying does not appear to be an issue in either school. Three parents do not feel that concerns have been addressed effectively but all other parents have given a positive response.

There has to date not been negative feedback regarding the soft federation. One parent commented on the additional opportunities for collaboration and others have either not commented or not seen many negative changes, apart from my reduced presence at Luddington.
